

## Parent Notice for New Form 1 Students

Dear Parents,

Parents of new Form 1 students in the next academic year (2025 – 2026) are requested to note the following matters. Your kind cooperation with the school is much appreciated.

### 1. Form 1 Registration Day

- Date and Time: 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 (9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.)
- Venue: School Hall
- Documents required:
1. Allocation Slip and Admission Form issued by the Education Bureau (Original)
  2. Identity documents (Original and photocopy)
  3. Recent School Report Cards (Original and photocopy)
  4. Certificate of Baptism &/or Confirmation (Original and photocopy) (For Catholic students only)
  5. Catholic Student Portfolio (For Catholic students from St. Rose of Lima's School only)

Parents are required to purchase the school uniform accessories (approximately \$70).

The school service providers will set up counters in Room G02 on G/F. Parents can choose to purchase items or services through the school.

Wai Fat Books & Stationers Ltd. (Wai Fat) will be our school textbook supplier next academic year. Students can enjoy a discount of 11% if they order the textbooks from the booklist through the school, and students can enjoy a discount of 8% if they purchase the textbooks in Wai Fat's retail shop. The booklist and the order form will be distributed on the Registration Day. Students have to order the textbooks in the online platform of Wai Fat. Students who have ordered the textbooks should bring back the order form and the receipt to collect their textbooks from **9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 in Room G02**. Students who cannot collect the books on the designated date have to collect their books from the Wai Fat's retail shop directly.

Fung Cheong Shun (Shatin) Limited will be our school summer uniform and P.E. uniform supplier. Students who have ordered the uniforms should bring back the order form and the receipt to collect their uniforms from **9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 in Room G02**. Students who cannot collect their uniforms on the designated date have to collect them from Fung Cheong Shun's retail shop (Shatin) directly.

Students can also ask their parents to help collect the books and uniforms on **29<sup>th</sup> July, 2025**. If the Education Bureau announces a class suspension due to bad weather, the day of collection of the textbooks and uniforms will be postponed to **30<sup>th</sup> July, 2025**. The time and venue remain unchanged.

The school has also set up counters for parents to order white leather shoes, sports shoes, and Visual Arts materials.

### 2. Streaming Test for New Form 1 Students (English Language, Chinese Language and Mathematics)

- Date and Time: 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 (Monday), 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

(All new students must reach school by 8:15 a.m.)

Remarks: Students are required to bring the Admission Form (issued by the school) and the Allocation Slip (issued by the Education Bureau) to attend the test.

To enhance students' academic standards, the school adopts the Streaming System in Form 1. Students will be allocated to classes based on their results in the Streaming Test and the Pre-S1 Hong Kong Attainment Test. Students who obtain the best results will be allocated to F.1A, while others will be evenly distributed to the other four classes. Students who do not perform satisfactorily in the "Pre-S1 Hong Kong Attainment Test" or "Streaming Test" need to complete additional homework during the summer vacation and return to school every Saturday morning in the coming school year to attend Betterment Classes, hoping that the students concerned can adapt to the secondary school curriculum as soon as possible and lay a solid foundation.

1. Students who are absent for the Streaming Test should submit a parent's letter to the General Office prior to or after the test.
2. Students can be in casual wear (Short-sleeved or long-sleeved tops and trousers).

If the Education Bureau announces a class suspension due to bad weather, the Streaming Test will be postponed. Details will be announced later.

### **3. Pre-S1 Hong Kong Attainment Test (English Language, Chinese Language and Mathematics)**

Date and Time: 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 (Tuesday), 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.  
(All new students must reach school by 8:30 a.m.)

Remarks: Students are required to bring the Admission Form (issued by the school) and the Allocation Slip (issued by the Education Bureau) to attend the test.

1. Students who are absent for the Pre-S1 Attainment test should submit a parent's letter to the General Office prior to or after the test.
2. Students can be in casual wear (Short-sleeved or long-sleeved tops and trousers).

If the Education Bureau announces a class suspension due to bad weather, the Test will be postponed to 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 (Wednesday)

#### 4. Summer Bridging Course for New Form 1 Students

Subjects:	Chinese, English and Mathematics (conducted in English)
Venue:	Classrooms or School Hall
Date:	21 <sup>st</sup> to 22 <sup>nd</sup> August, 2025 and 25 <sup>th</sup> to 28 <sup>th</sup> August, 2025 (6 days)
Time:	8:15 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
Fee:	HK\$100
Remarks:	Students should dress tidily and decently in casual wear (Short-sleeved or long-sleeved tops and trousers) during the course. If a student cannot attend the class because of sick leave, parents are requested to inform the school by calling 2337 1867; and a parent's letter with a medical certificate should be submitted on the day of return. In case of an application for casual leave or early leave, students are required to submit a parent's letter three working days prior to the leave. Parents are requested NOT to arrange travel during the Summer Bridging Course. In case of a class suspension announced by the Education Bureau due to bad weather, the Summer Bridging Course on that day will be cancelled.

#### 5. Form 1 Orientation Day

Parents and New Form 1 students are invited to attend the Form 1 Orientation Day, which aims to introduce the school to students (e.g. School Calendar, Timetable, School Regulations, Student Support and the Curriculum in Junior Forms, etc.).

Date and Time:	30 <sup>th</sup> August, 2025 (Saturday) at 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.
Remarks:	Students should <u>wear full summer school uniform</u> on that day. (Details to be announced later.)

#### 6. School Re-opens

Date and Time:	1 <sup>st</sup> September, 2025 (Monday) at 8:05 a.m.
Remarks:	Students should wear full summer school uniforms on that day. Students do not need to bring their textbooks, but they should bring paper and pens to the school. School will end at around 12:00 noon. All Catholic students are required to attend the Form 1 Catholic Students' Gathering from 11:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m..

#### 7. Day Camp for Form 1 Students

Time and Venue:	9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Details to be announced later) All Form One students are required to attend the Day Camp. Students should be in casual wear and trousers on that day.
